During heavy rains in 2020, it became obvious that severe erosion has been going on in the southwest corner of the lake for many years, and that this needed to be remedied as soon as possible before it resulted in major property damage.



The erosion has washed away between 6 and 10 feet of soil bordering lots on the west side of the lake over the years, with the result that heavy rains create floods in areas outside the overflow spillway corridor.

The Board has hired S.P.C. Inc. to restore the shoreline in the southwest corner of the lake by building a shot rock base and infilling with clay and topsoil. Work was to have begun in January, but has been delayed by bad weather.

Mr. Tom Ratermann at the Boone County Regional Sewer District informs us that a major upgrade project is underway at the pumping station next to our lake. This project will include:

- 1) Replacing the aging electrical panel
- 2) Replacing the pumps.
- 3) Building a retaining wall around the pump station to prevent storm water from running down the gravel access road and the back of the dam into the pump.

Mr. Raterman said this project "won't take months, but definitely weeks, unless there is a lot of rain delaying the work."
