The Rain in Spain Falls Mainly in Shalimar Gardens!



All the rain that falls in Shalimar Gardens ends up in our Lake, and when it rains it dilutes the bacteria count in the water, and reduces the amount of algae bloom on the surface. Due to dry weather this year, we are going to test the water in June to find out if it is safe for swimming and fishing. If the weather continues to be dry, we will re-test in July and August.

If the results indicate that the lake is not safe for swimming and fishing, signs will be posted on both the east and west side of the lake to alert all members and visitors.

Lake Rules

Are you aware that there are rules for using the Lake and the Common Area surrounding it? These rules are clearly posted. Please do not let your children swim in the Lake without adult supervision.
